

Sideways Triangular Shawl

Increasing edge

Cast on 4 stitches.

Row 1: Slip the first stitch purlwise, with yarn in front. Knit to end of row.

Row 2: Cast on 2 stitches using the cable knit cast on. Bind off two stitches, yarn over, knit to end of row.

Rows 3 – 5: Slip the first stitch purlwise, with yarn in front. Knit to end of row.

Repeat rows 2 - 5 until shawl is about half the length you want. End with Row 5.

Center – Straight Edge

Row 6: Cast on 2 stitches. Bind off two stitches yarn over, k2tog, knit to end.

Rows 7 – 9: Slip the first stitch purlwise, with yarn in front. Knit to end of row.

Repeat rows 6 – 9 until the center section is the desired length. End with Row 9.

(The sample has just one repeat of the center rows.)

Decreasing Edge

Row 10: Cast on 2 stitches. Bind off two stitches yarn over, k2tog * 2, knit to end.

Rows 11 – 13: Slip the first stitch purlwise, with yarn in front. Knit to end of row.

Repeat Rows 10 – 13 until only 5 stitches remain, ending with Row 13.

Repeat Row 10. (You should now have 4 stitches.)

Repeat Row 11.

Bind off.

The sample was made with two skeins of Cascade's Souk, on size 7 needles.
